Students Feedback Report 2017-18

I. Reason for selecting the College

The College collected feedback from the students on their decision to select the Course/College for their higher studies. For this purpose the opinion of the students on six factors was elicited. The six factors are Interest in the Subject, Ease of Getting Admission, and Reputation of the Department Job Opportunities, Influence of Parents / School Teachers / Friends and Nearness to the College. The opinion of the students was anchored on a 6 point scale. 'Interest in the subject' (mean = 4.9) was identified as the main reason for their selection. Reputation of the teachers was identified as the second. As the number of Ph. D holders among the faculty and the number of seminars and conferences held by the college annually has increased, the academic reputation of the College appears to have enhanced . It is clear from the table that the role of influence of parents, school teachers and friends is negligible as the mean value is less than 3.

52% of the students who opted this College for higher studies unanimously opined that they were able to realize their expectations in higher education through this College. Only 8% students have felt dismayed with the College while 40% were able to realize their dreams to a certain extent.

III. General Opinion about the College

The College collected feedback from students on academic and administrative infrastructure based on 25 variables and the opinion was fixed on a 4 point scale. Opinion about the

Syllabus, Quality of Teaching, Head of the Department, Effectiveness of the Bridge Course, Adequacy of Newspapers/ Periodicals/ E-Journals, Adequacy of Materials and Devices in Laboratories, Cooperation of the Laboratory Staff, Computer/Internet/Photostat Accessibility, NCC/NSS, Sports and Games, Encouragement for Communal and Social Work, Womens' Cell Activities, Accessibility of Library Books/Journals and Cooperation of the Library Staff ranked high as the mean value was above 3. The students registered their dissatisfaction only on the hostel and Canteen facility.
