RULES & REGULATIONS

- Only the P.G. Projects of the M.Sc Biotechnology program of the academic year 2021-22, of any university/ affiliated/ autonomous college in India, (Aided/Self-financed) are eligible for participation in the contest. Projects from the previous years or any institutions outside India are not eligible.
- Participants should fill in the Google form on or before 8th October 2022 to complete the process of registration.
- Each applicant should pay a registration fee of Rs. 100/-. The amount should be paid via Gpay.
- The winner receives a cash reward of ₹ 3000/--, while the first and second runners-up will receive ₹ 1500/-- and ₹ 500/--, respectively, along with a Certificate of Merit.
- All the projects will not automatically become eligible for presentation in the contest. There will be an initial screening by an expert panel to shortlist the 10 best projects for the final contest.
- The selected contestants will be invited to make a formal presentation of 7 minutes and a discussion of 3 minutes in the College.
- The projects will be evaluated by the two eminent academicians and the results will be declared in the function.
- The decisions of the judging committee shall be final and binding to all the contestants.
